DAY 1: GRASKOP, SOUTH AFRICA

On arrival at OR Tambo International Airport, please proceed to Avis Car Hire depot to collect your hired car. From Johannesburg you will head east towards Mpumalanga. A landscape characterized by mountains, panoramic passes, valleys, rivers, waterfalls and forests. You spend the night in the town of Graskop, a small forestry town situated on the Drakensberg Escarpment at the start of the Panorama route and the gateway to the Kruger National Park. The rest of the afternoon is yours to spend at leisure.

Accommodation: Graskop Hotel or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, bar & restaurant)

DAY 2 & 3: HAZYVIEW, SOUTH AFRICA

This morning you will start with your scenic drive along the Panorama Route, arguably one of the most beautiful destinations in South Africa. The most spectacular stretch is the Blyde River Canyon, which is the 3rd largest canyon in the world, and filled with lush vegetation and wildlife. The following day you will have an opportunity to visit the world famous Kruger National Park.

Accommodation: Casa Do Sol or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, bar & restaurant)

DAY 4: MHLAMBANYATSI, ESWATINI

B

Today you cross the border into the mountainous Kingdom of eSwatini, led by King Mswati III, and one of the 3 monarchies in Africa. You will explore the traditions and discover the culture of which the Swazis are so proud. En route you will have the opportunity to visit the Ngwenha Glass Factory.

Accommodation: Foresters Arms or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, bar & restaurant)

DAY 5 & 6: MKUZE, SOUTH AFRICA

Today you will re-enter South Africa via Northern Kwa-Zulu Natal. Continue to Ghost Mountain Inn, situated at the foot of the legendary Ghost Main in Mkuze. You will have the opportunity to embark on the following optional game activities; open vehicle game drive in the Mkuze Game Reserve, guided walks, cultural excursions and boat cruises.

Accommodation: Ghost Mountain Inn or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, bar & restaurant)

DAY 7: ST LUCIA, SOUTH AFRICA

B

Today you will drive to iSimangaliso Wetland Park, which was listed as South Africa's first World Heritage Site. This afternoon you will be able to partake in an optional boat cruise on the St Lucia estuary, getting up close to the hippos and crocodiles that inhabit the lake.

Accommodation: Lidiko Lodge or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool)

DAY 8: BALITO, SOUTH AFRICA

B

Today you will make your way to the coastal city of Durban. Experience some of the many diverse

pursuits and visit enchanting locations within easy reach or simply relax on the golden sandy beaches to soak up the African sun.

Accommodation: Riverside Hotel or similar (rooms with en-suite bathrooms, swimming pool, bar and restaurant)

This morning after breakfast, drive to King Shaka International Airport to drop off your hire car in time for your departure flight. We hope to welcome you on one of our African adventures again soon.

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION

TRANSPORT:

This self-drive safari includes car rental from Avis Car Hire, group B (VW Polo Vivo or similar), with premium insurance cover.

Premium insurance includes: Theft and collision damage waiver, personal accident insurance, unlimited mileage, location surcharge, third party liability insurance, general public liability insurance, tourism levy, VAT and claim admin fee, tyre, rim and hubcap damage, windscreen damage/repair, sandblasting damage, water and undercarriage damage.

Excludes: Fuel, refundable rental deposit, rental contract fee, one way drop off charges, delivery and collection fees, traffic fine administration fee, additional driver, child safety seats, GPS navigation, additional spare tyre rental and deposit.

ACCOMMODATION:

We make use of mid-range typical African standard lodge accommodation. The accommodation will be a mix of lodges, with en-suite bathrooms. Some properties are equipped with swimming pools, restaurants and/or bar areas.

MEALS:

Breakfasts will be in restaurants at the various accommodation establishments. Please advise us of any special dietary requirements in advance.

VISAS:

The onus is on the client to organize all visas required to visit South Africa and eSwatini prior to departure.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Please note that travel and cancellation insurance is mandatory for every guest travelling with Jenman African Safaris. All insurance is solely the responsibility of our guests.
