

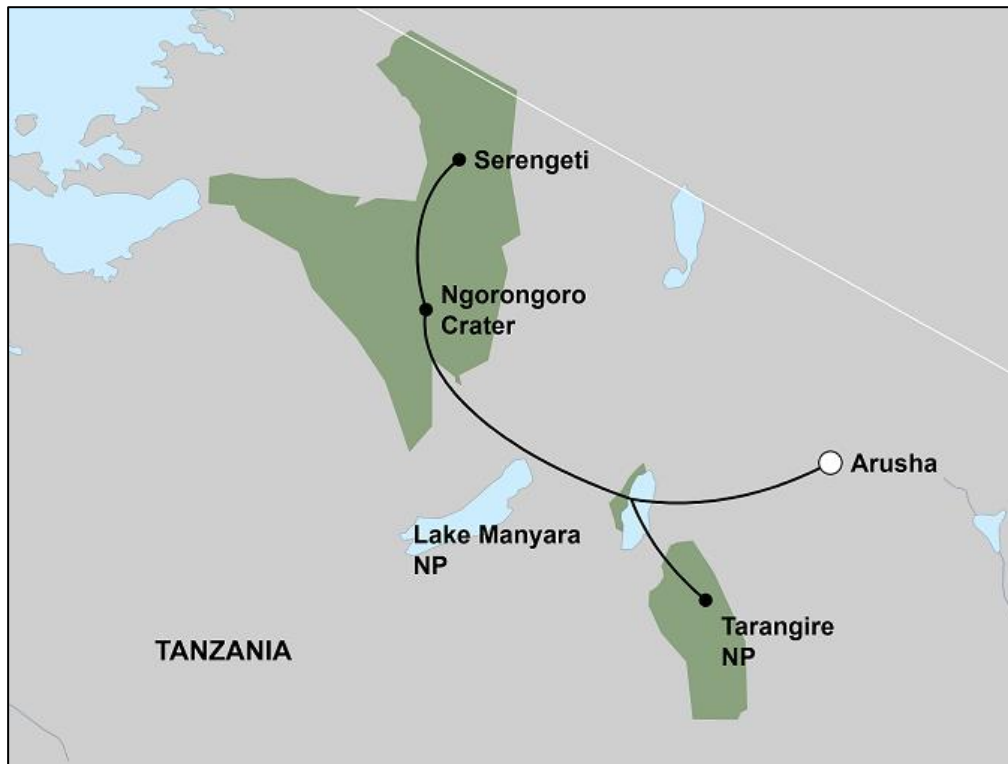


TANZANIA WILDLIFE BREAKAWAY

DAY 3: MANYARA NATIONAL PARK, TANZANIA

BLD

We head towards Lake Manyara National Park for an early morning game drive. The spectacular national park is located at the north-western corner of Lake Manyara, a hallow soda lake, which lies at the foot of the Great Rift Valley's western escarpment. Manyara NP is not only known for its large flocks of flamingos, but also for the elusive tree climbing lions.

Distance: 120 km **Driving time:** 3-4 hours

Accommodation: Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

Breakfast: At Tarangire Simba Lodge or similar

Lunch: Picnic Lunch from Tarangire Simba Lodge or similar

Dinner: At Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

DAY 4: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK, TANZANIA

BLD

After breakfast we drive up the Rift Valley escarpment towards the world famous Ngorongoro Crater. For many, this wildlife spectacle is the pinnacle of their safari experience. The Ngorongoro Crater boasts all of the 'Big 5', including a small population of endangered black rhino. After a picnic lunch, we head towards the Serengeti through the stunning Southern Plains. This is the area that the Serengeti is best known for – the endless, undulating grass savannah with rocky outcrops that serve as isolated wildlife refuges.

Distance: 400 km (including the Crater) **Driving time:** 6-7 hours

Accommodation: Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Breakfast: At Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

Lunch: Picnic lunch from Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

Dinner: At Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

DAY 5: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK, TANZANIA

BLD

Today you will be spending a full day game driving around the Seronera area of the Serengeti. The Serengeti is divided into three main areas: Seronera is the most central and accessible region and this is where the Park HQ is based, as well as most of the larger lodges and communal campsites. This part of the Serengeti is characterised by open plains of grassland, packed with animals. The Seronera River is the lifeblood of the Serengeti and this area is renowned for great game viewing all year round. It is also particularly good for lion and cheetah sightings, as well as the most elusive of all big cats, the leopard.

Accommodation: Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Breakfast: At Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Lunch: Picnic lunch from Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Dinner: At Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

DAY 6: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK – NGORONGORO CRATER – LAKE MANYAR

BLD

Today we retrace our steps with a morning game drive through the Serengeti followed by a picnic lunch, before we continue through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. En route we visit Olduvai Gorge.

Distance: 200 km **Driving time:** 5-6 hours

Accommodation: Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

Breakfast: At Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Lunch: Picnic lunch from Kisura Serengeti Camp or similar

Dinner: At Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

DAY 7: LAKE MANYARA – ARUSHA

BL

After breakfast we explore the colourful town of Mto-wa-Mbu for some last-minute pictures and curio shopping. Afterwards we head to Arusha where the tour will end. We hope to welcome you again on one of our African adventures!

Distance: 250 km **Driving time:** 3-4 hours

Breakfast: At Karatu Simba Lodge or similar

PRE-DEPARTURE INFORMATION

DEPARTURE:

The Tanzania Wildlife Breakaway departs from the African Tulip Hotel in Arusha. When arriving in Arusha on day one, you will be picked up from the airport and transferred to your lodge. Should you arrive prior to day one, pre-tour accommodation can be arranged and you will be picked up from your hotel on the morning of day.

After breakfast on day 2, there will be a pre-departure meeting presented by your guide at your accommodation. It is imperative that all clients attend this meeting so as not to miss out on any critical information.

Whilst it is our every intention to adhere to the above mentioned itinerary, there may on occasion be a necessity to make alterations in order to make the tour more enjoyable or practical. Therefore please treat the itinerary as a guide only.

TRANSPORT:

Jenman African Safaris uses fully equipped, customized, 4x4 safari vehicles, Toyota Land Cruisers, or other appropriate vehicles with comfortable seating, all window seats for game viewing and a music system. These non-air-conditioned vehicles are equipped with pop-up roofs to facilitate the best game viewing. All luggage, besides hand luggage and photo equipment, is carried on the vehicle roof rack or trailer to ensure maximum comfort in the vehicle.

TRAVELLING TIMES AND DISTANCES:

All travelling times are affected by road conditions, border crossings, detours and weather conditions, therefore on certain days travelling times may be longer than anticipated especially where there is a lot of distance to be covered. Please keep in mind that the time it takes to travel 100 km in your home country is not equivalent to the time it takes to travel 100 km on African roads, therefore we encourage you to sit

back and enjoy the spectacular scenery Africa has to offer. Where possible additional stops will be made to ensure your travelling comfort at all times.

ACCOMMODATION:

For this accommodated safari, we make use of mid-range lodge accommodation. Your accommodation is situated either in National Parks, on the banks of a river, or in other places of interest. The accommodation will be a mix of lodges, chalets and permanent tented chalets with en-suite facilities. Some properties are equipped with swimming pools and/or bar areas.

MEALS:

Breakfast and dinner will be prepared by the lodge where you are staying. They will also prepare lunch or a lunch pack depending on the itinerary for the day. Please advise us of any special dietary requirements in advance.

TIPPING GUIDELINES FOR GUIDES

It is recommended that you tip between \$5 - \$10 per person per day.

VISAS:

The onus is on the client to organize all visas required to visit Tanzania, prior to departure.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Please note that travel and cancellation insurance is mandatory for every guest travelling with Jenman African Safaris. All insurance is solely the responsibility of our guests. Please ensure you arrange your own insurance with protection for the full duration of your journey to cover personal injury, damage and loss of personal items including but not limited to camera equipment and other electronic items, medical expenses, repatriation expenses and loss of luggage, etc. Please speak to your travel agent if you require assistance.
